**Warm Up Question** - What does Father's Day mean to you?

**Teaching Text:** Revelation 21:1-8

**Study Questions:** (Study questions are meant to support better understanding of the teaching text or encourage further study.)

1. What does it mean that God is "the Alpha and the Omega"?
2. How does Revelation 21:1–8 fulfill God's promises throughout Scripture?
3. What does God's desire to dwell with His people reveal about His character?
4. Why do you think the absence of death, mourning, crying, and pain is emphasized?
5. How does the image of the water of life connect to Jesus' teaching in the Gospels?
6. What warning is given in verse 8?

**Application Questions:** (Application questions are intended to promote conversation on how God is directing us to apply the sermon, either personally or to the group as a whole.)

1. Which future hope in this passage stands out most to you? How are you experiencing this promise now and how do you envision experiencing this promise in the future?
2. What areas of your life need to be surrendered to God for renewal?
3. How can this passage help us comfort someone who is grieving or suffering?
4. Reflect on our AKA series.
  - What did you learn about God's character? Anything new?
  - What "I AM" statement was most impactful for you and why?
  - What new questions has this series brought about?

**Pray:** Take time together to listen to the Spirit's leading and pray God's will for one another.

**Bonus:** Isaiah 65:17–25 "See I will create a new heaven and a new earth..."
