Teaching Series - Partnering in God's Work **Sermon Date** - Sunday Nov 9, 2025

Warm Up Question - Have you ever started a big project or repair job that looked impossible at first? How did it turn out?

Teaching Text: Nehemiah 2:1-20

Study Questions: (Study questions are meant to support better understanding of the teaching text or encourage further study.)

- 1. Why was Nehemiah afraid to appear sad before King Artaxerxes? What does this reveal about the risks he was taking?
- 2. Why do you think Nehemiah kept his plans secret at first (v. 12)? When might it be wise for us to be discreet about God's plans or our calling?
- 3. How did the people respond to Nehemiah's call? What does this teach about unity and shared vision?

Application Questions: (Application questions are intended to promote conversation on how God is directing us to apply the sermon, either personally or to the group as a whole.)

- 1. What moments of courage, of costly uncompromised focus have you experienced while partnering with God in His work? What uncompromised focus moments is your moved heart being prepared for?
- 2. What work can only God do in the work He's called you to partner with Him in? Whose heart does God need to move? What door needs to open?
- 3. What will be needed of you when God's gracious hand does the work only God can do, changing the circumstances you've been praying into. Are you prepared?
- 4. What does "doing the partnering work" look like in your life?

Pray: Take time together to listen to the Spirit's leading and pray God's will for one another.

Bonus: Proverbs 21 "The king's heart is in the hand of the Lord; he directs it like a watercourse wherever he pleases."
